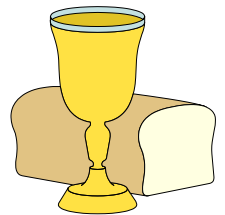
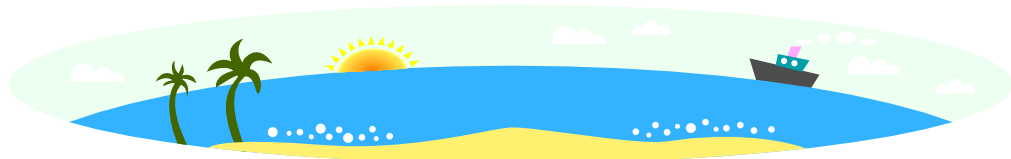
There will be a **Wagin Congregation Meeting Sunday 17 November 2024 after the service.**

The Church Council will meet **Saturday 23 November, 2024, 9.00 am** at the back of the Church.

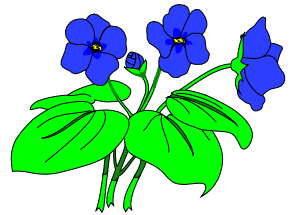
