### **NUTRITION AWARENESS CAMPAIGN**

Unfortunately, almost half (49.5%) of all children in Papua New Guinea have stunted growth, indicating long-term malnutrition. Most adults and children only eat two meals a day. Over 5% of pregnant women are underweight, which impacts the development of their baby in utero.

We are about halfway through our Nutrition Awareness Campaign with the Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations, having so far reached over 3,000 people virtually with our social media and radio content, 2,048 men, women and children in our face-to-face workshops in remote villages, and 43 health workers in face-to-face seminars. This has been a huge effort from our amazing staff and volunteers in PNG and they have done a fantastic job to organise all the logistics - Ruth, Naomi, Gina, John and Sr Linda, we are very lucky to have you on Team Living Child!
